### Invacare® Reliant 350 Stand Assist

Stand assist lifters provide safe, comfortable, powered assistance from one seated position to another, for people who have limited mobility and/or rehabilitation needs. Individuals should have some weight bearing ability, be able to co-operate with instructions and have equal strength on both sides.

The Reliant 350 stand assist is ideal in single carer\* situations to support the safe completion of an **assisted seated to seated transfer**. This easy to use stand assist limits the amount of complexity required to carry out straightforward transfers. It can be set up and demonstrated easily allowing family and carers to be trained quickly in its safe use.

The manual leg operation can be operated with ease, and the clearly laid out handset with arrow indication allows smooth raise and lower functions. The small overall product footprint enables discreet storage in domestic environments and reduces any anxiety of clinical equipment overload.

The high battery capacity, off board charger and spare battery as standard, helps those concerned with keeping the product charged ready for use at all times. An emergency lower function is easily explained.
